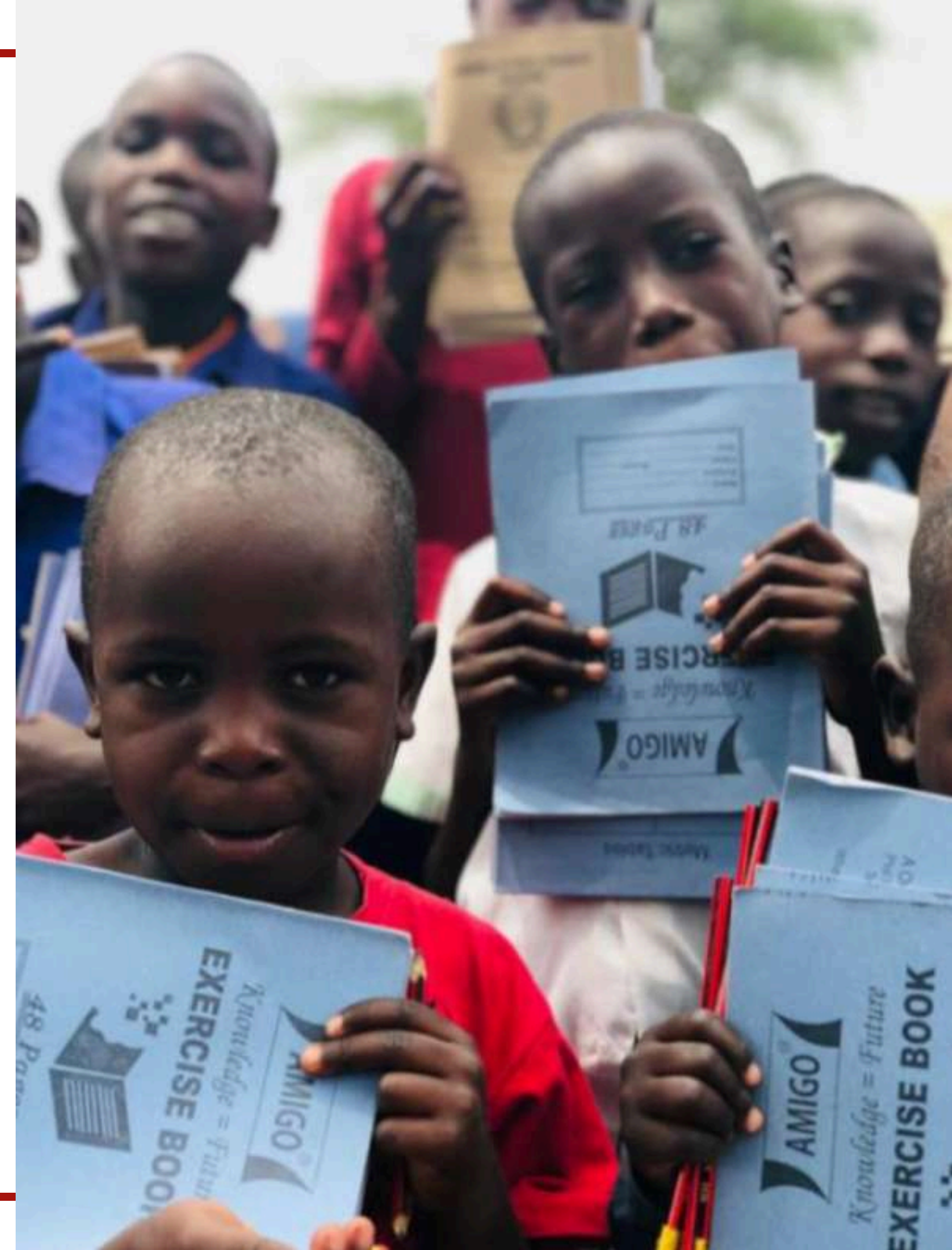

- Non-profit, **community-based organisation (CBO)** based in Masaka, District, Central Uganda.
  - Registered member under Masaka District and a **Company Limited by Guarantee**.
- Dedicated to enhancing the livelihoods of marginalised and disadvantaged communities.
  - Education and Healthcare.

**Vision:** To become the leading organisation to facilitate transformative development.

**Mission:** To provide assistance to under privileged groups.

- Programmes and activities centred around the **United Nation's Sustainable Development Goals**.
  - (1) No poverty, (2) zero hunger, (3) good health and wellbeing, (4) quality education, (5) gender equality, (6) clean water and sanitation and (11) sustainable cities and communities.

# BRIEF HISTORY

## STUDENTS TO CHANGE-MAKERS



- Formated by students from Kampala University undertaking a research project where they recognised the lack of schools and healthcare access.
  - There was also a lack of support for communities' most vulnerable.
- Created as Dream King's Foundation in 2019.
- Registered with Masaka City Council as a CBO in 2021.
  - Name change to Dream Heart Foundation.
- Became a Company Limited by Guarantee in 2022.
- Since formation, DHEF has conducted multiple activities in Masaka and wider Uganda:
  - Menstral hygiene counselling and item distribution.
  - Community clean ups.
  - Learning material distribution.
  - Implementing washroom facilities and water pumps.
  - Food distribution during COVID-19.
  - Present in sustainable agriculture and HIV/AIDS meetings.

## Education Aid

Provide educational materials and cover school fees for orphaned, street-connected, and vulnerable children living in both rural areas and urban slums of Masaka, Uganda. 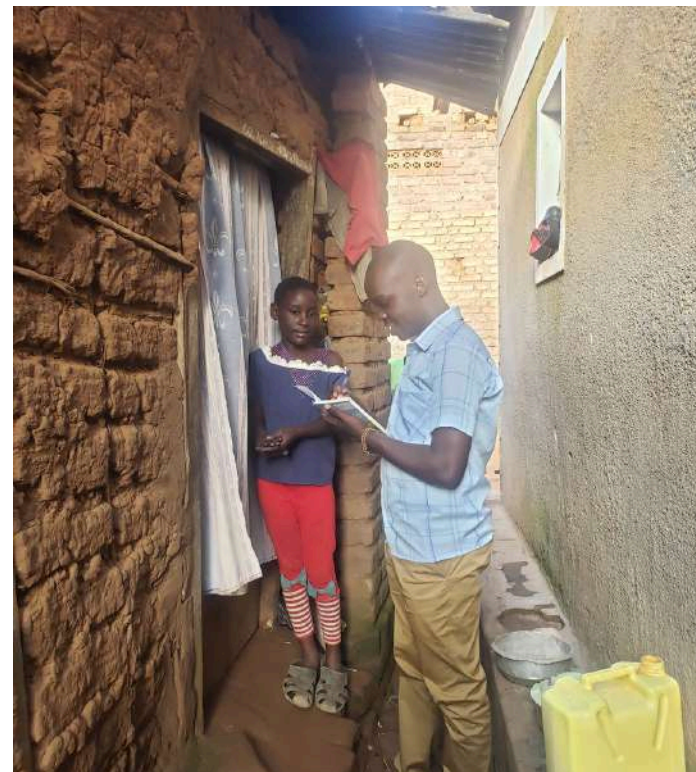
